Hiking Safety

Whether on a short trail or longer hike, please note the following:

- ✓ Inform your host establishment which trail(s) you are hiking and what time you expect to be back. Ensure that they have everyone's cellphone numbers.

- ✓ Park in designated areas only.
- ✓ Make sure your vehicle is securely locked and that no valuables are visible.
- ✓ Keep to designated, signposted and well-used tracks.
- ✓ If mist/bad weather/darkness come in, find shelter close by and stay there until it is safe to move on or help arrives.
- ✓ Take only photos and your litter.



Make sure you have the following items with you:

- ✓ A map of the Hogsback hikes (on sale at The Adventure Centre, Main Road)
- ✓ Warm, weatherproof clothing. (Mist and bad weather move in fast) on the mountain.)
- ✓ A full water bottle for each hiker
- ✓ Fully charged cellphones
- ✓ Bags for all your litter
